N.B- The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in order dated 02.08.2018, passed in the Interlocutory Application No.279 of 2010 in Writ Petition (Civil) No.1022 of 1989 (**All India Judges Association & Ors versus Union of India & Ors**), has observed as follows: *"The Court development plan should comprise of three component- short term (or annual plan); a medium term plan (or a five year plan); and a long term plan (ten year plan). The annual plans so prepared shall be incorporated into the five year plan which, in turn, rolls into the ten year plan."*

Step to taken for Reduction of Pending Cases

Number cases pending as on 30.09.2018	Proposed plan for disposal of cases, especially cases pending for more than five/ten years and above.
4676	<p><u>The following steps are taken for disposal of more than five/ten years old cases:</u></p> <p>i) All the old cases are separated and equally distributed with other courts.</p> <p>ii) For quick service of process in time a meeting has been convened wherein all Judicial Officers, Superintendent of Police and Deputy Commissioner were present. In the said meeting Superintendent of Police was asked to take all possible measures for causing service of summons specially issued to witness relating to cases identified as old pending in time.</p> <p>iii) In the aforesaid meeting the SP Karbi Anglong was also asked to keep strict vigilance for causing execution of NBWA and P&A against the accused persons so that</p>

	<p>appearance of the accused person could be completed for trial.</p> <p>iv) Process regarding the old pending cases is being marked as old pending so that service of the same can be caused on priority basis.</p> <p>v) The courts are taking hearing of the cases more than 5 years old on priority basis. In such cases adjournment is granted in only urgent ground. Lawyers from both sides are also co-operating without hesitation.</p> <p>vi) In the court of the undersigned everyday more than 10 nos. of witnesses turn up and their deposition are successfully recorded. Similarly in other courts under my Judgement ship everyday sufficient number of witness is turning up.</p> <p>vii) All Judicial officers are making full endeavour to dispose of maximum numbers of old pending cases to their best.</p>
